

Celebrating women

March 8 is observed as International Women's Day. Every year, Sehgal Foundation organizes women's conclaves in villages to mark this occasion. This year these events and others were organized across Haryana, Rajasthan, Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, and Karnataka. The objective was to provide participants an important and interactive platform to discuss their achievements and challenges, to interact and share with another their experiences, and to learn from the outputs in order to help build a more developed community. The conclave also sought to enhance the participation of women in village governance and village governing bodies.

More than 500 women *sushasan* (governance) champions participated in women's leadership schools in meetings, rallies, trainings, and games. Prizes were a part of the programs. Women shared their experiences on gender equality, empowerment, and talked about their role models.
