Jay Sehgal and his wife Veena enjoy living in the Woodlands neighborhood of Clive, where they share a commitment to making a positive difference in the world. They have been involved in a philanthropic organization called Sehgal Foundation for more than 18 years, where Jay serves as executive vice president. But their life journeys began in India.

Jay moved to Iowa first in 1977 at age 15 to live with his aunt and uncle, Dr. Suri Sehgal and Edda Sehgal. He attended Urbandale High School, then the University of Iowa, majoring in computer science. He joined the family seed business, Proagro Seed Company Ltd., where he met Veena while working in India. Veena earned a master's degree in Business Management from Osmania University in Hyderabad, India. They married in Hyderabad in 1995.

Veena and Jay have two sons, Sachin and Rohit, who embrace their family commitment to honesty, respecting all cultures, seeking spiritual awareness, promoting happiness, being friendly to others, and being responsible community members. The family has been living in Iowa since 2006.

Sachin and Rohit help with Sehgal Foundation's activities to help the rural poor in India and also participate in school volunteer programs. Sachin is in Iowa City attending Kirkwood Community College pursuing Entrepreneurship and Business Management. He loves to read, watch sports, listen to music, and research financial investments. He played soccer in high school. Rohit attends Iowa State University majoring in Computer Science. He is a technology buff and likes coding and mathematics. He loves watching wrestling and wrestled in high school.

The Sehgal family members all over the world, and their philanthropic work involves travel. When not traveling for work they have visited Germany, France, UK, Austria, Thailand, Philippines, Malaysia, Japan, and Egypt. A recent fun trip took them to the Maldives and Jamaica, and plans are in the works to go to Cairo and Jordan with close friends who are also their neighbors.

Veena is an IT project manager for a bank system and Jay is fully immersed in his work with Sehgal Foundation. He follows the Iowa Hawkeyes, Kansas City Royals, and Dallas Cowboys and enjoys walking in the woods, listening to music, and volunteer work as time permits. Veena enjoys reading, exercise, yoga, meditation, traveling, and volunteer work.

The Sehgal family has devoted their lives to helping others and after a short visit with Jay you see the importance the Sehgal Foundation has played in his life. The Sehgal Foundation was established by his aunt and uncle, Dr. Suri Sehgal and Edda Sehgal, in 1998 in India, and 1999 in the US, based in Des Moines. The foundation work began by supporting the development of several villages in the Mewat district, not far from India's capital city, New Delhi. By involving community members and gaining support from donors, the foundation has been successfully building water conservation structures such as check dams and rainwater harvesting systems, creating community centers and teaching life skills education and digital literacy to schoolchildren, helping farmers use best practices to increase their produce and incomes, and teaching villagers about the government programs and benefits. Every program is focused on gender equality and empowering women and girls. A community center houses a community radio

The Sehgal Foundation in the US supports numerous local, regional, national, and global efforts for conservation, ecology, and development. With the help of many families in the Des Moines area, an Iowa chapter of Sehgal Foundation was created to support the work being done in rural India. A key campaign is to Transform Lives one school at a time, which involves providing rural schools with safe building structures and school grounds, clean drinking water, separate toilets for girls and boys, a hygienic kitchen for food preparation for midday meals, and important trainings in self-esteem, self-care, and how to be empowered citizens.
